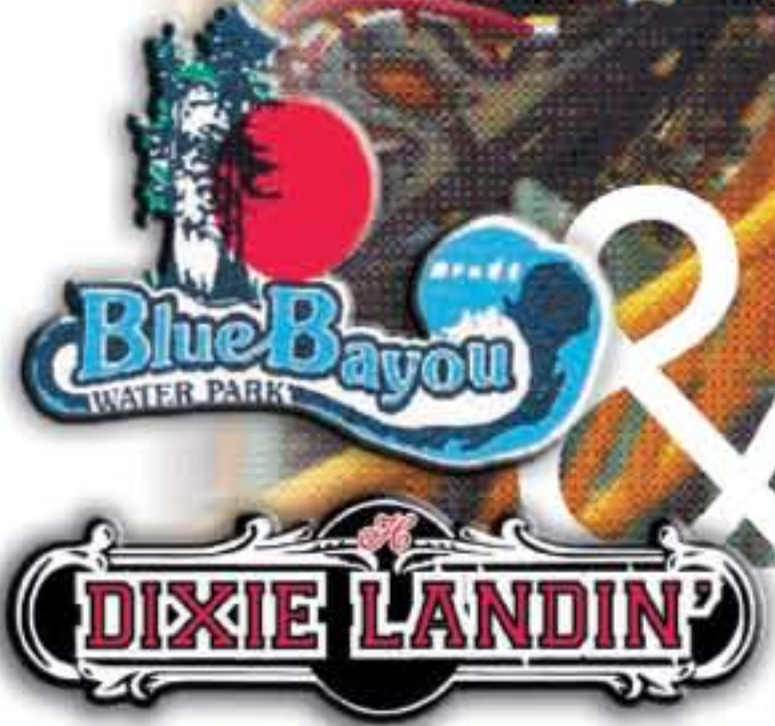

By participating in Louisiana FCU's Skip-A-Payment program, you request that Louisiana FCU defer your loan payments as indicated. You agree and understand that: 1) Loans must have originated 60 days prior to be eligible; 2) All co-signers of the loan must agree to the Skip-A-Pay program and sign the request; 3) FINANCE CHARGES will continue to accrue at the rate provided in your original loan agreement, during and after this time; 4) Deferring your payment will result in your having to pay higher total FINANCE CHARGES than if you made your payment as originally scheduled; 5) The payment deferral will extend the terms of your loan(s); 6) You will be required to resume your payments the following month. If you elected GAP or Warranty Coverage, the coverage will not be extended beyond the original maturity date. All deferrals are subject to Louisiana FCU approval. Your loan(s) must be current for at least 90 days to accept this offer. Excludes all Real Estate Loans, tuition loans, and credit cards.

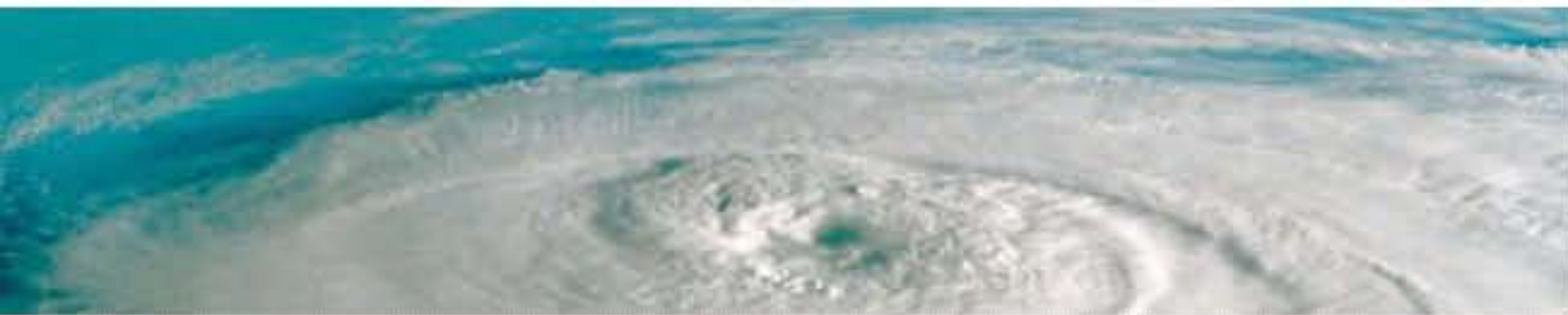

Disasters and Your Money

"Ensuring safety" is our #1 goal for both members and employees during hurricane season. Being safe means being prepared. Here's how Louisiana FCU is helping you prepare:

Louisiana FCU branches will close 36 hours before a Category 3 (or higher) hurricane is predicted to make landfall on the Louisiana coastline. This closure ensures the safety of all our members and employees.

Get Cash Early.


Be sure to visit any Louisiana FCU branch at least 36 hours before predicted landfall.

Ask Your Employer About Direct Deposit.

Don't rely on paper checks during a disaster—especially if you must evacuate. Direct deposit ensures your money is in your account immediately. Use your checks, debit card, or CU Service Center to withdraw funds wherever you are—and direct deposit is a free service.

Get a Check Card.

Use this card to pay for goods at merchants or to withdraw money at ATMs—anywhere Mastercard is accepted.

Order an Extra Box of Checks.

With so much talk about plastic, who would have ever thought we'd suggest paper checks? If there's no power, merchants may accept checks. This is just another alternative of ensuring access to your money.

Try Online Banking.

No matter where you are, you can have free access to your accounts from any internet connection—but sign up now so you can be prepared.

Discover CU Service Centers.

Even if you are away from home, you can walk into any one of the 2,200 CU Service Center locations nationwide just as if you were standing in your own credit union branch. All you need is your Louisiana FCU account number and a valid ID. Find the closest CU Service Center near you by calling 1-800-919-CUSC.

ALERT ALERT

Turn on the evening news and you'll probably hear the word "scam" at least once. At your Credit Union, we make it our business to keep you informed of local scams that affect our members right here in our own community.

In the past few weeks, we've spoken to members affected by "skimming"—a technique used by criminals to steal the information off of that dark strip on the back of credit and debit cards.

How does "skimming" work? What might look like a normal ATM machine actually has a false faceplate or fake card reader that a customer would insert or swipe a card through. The skimmer device reads all the account information stored on the magnetic strip; thereby allowing the criminal to create a duplicate card without you knowing. Members should take special caution when using any ATM machine. Here are a few tips to avoid becoming a skimming victim:

- > Look at the ATM before using it. If it doesn't look right, don't use it & report it to the ATM owner.
- > Be on the lookout for signs of ATM tampering—loose connections, tape, or loose wires.
- > Don't give your PIN to anyone.
- > Check your statements to make sure there are no unauthorized withdrawals.
