## 2010 CANDIDATES FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCHES

**BILL COLLINS** (*incumbent*) attended Louisiana Tech and University of New Orleans. He retired 30+ years from Shell Oil Company and 1+ years from Motiva Norco Refining. He has been a member of the Louisiana FCU Board of Directors since 1982 where he served as Chairman, Second Vice Chair, and presently as First Vice Chair. His credit union education includes all modules for Board of Directors, Credit & Supervisory Committees, plus all advanced modules. He served on the Executive, Asset Liability Management, Annual Meeting, and Education Committees. He is presently Chair of Policy and Facilities Committees, a member of Louisiana Engineering Society, and has owned a Computer Consultant business since 2003.
